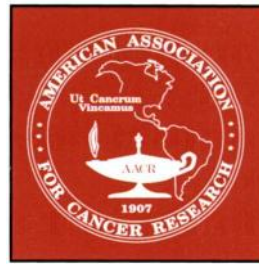

Submission of Manuscripts

Clinical Cancer Research, a new journal of the American Association for Cancer Research, publishes original articles describing clinical research on the cellular and molecular characterization, prevention, diagnosis, and therapy of human cancer. Its focus is on innovative clinical research and translational research which bridges the laboratory and the clinic. *Clinical Cancer Research* is especially interested in clinical trials evaluating new treatments for cancer; research on molecular abnormalities that predict incidence, response to therapy, and outcome; and laboratory studies of new drugs and biological agents that will lead to clinical trials in patients. All submissions undergo peer review. In the case of articles supported by federal grants or contracts, copyright transfer to the American Association for Cancer Research, Inc., is required. The federal government may retain a nonexclusive license to publish or republish such material.

The Journal will routinely allow authors (or others with the permission of the authors) to include select parts of a copyrighted article in reviews, books, or subsequent papers, upon written request to the AACR Director of Publications. Requests to reproduce an article in its entirety will be considered on an individual basis and permission may be granted contingent upon payment of an appropriate copyright fee.
