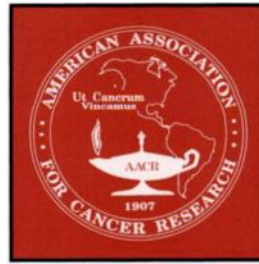

The Developmental Therapeutics Department, Medicine Branch is recruiting for a tenure-track position within the Division of Clinical Sciences, National Cancer Institute, National Institutes of Health, Bethesda, MD. The successful candidate must hold an M.D. degree, be board certified in Internal Medicine and board eligible in Medical Oncology by the American Board of Internal Medicine, have expertise in clinical pharmacology analytic methodology, be facile with pharmacokinetic analysis and modeling, and be capable of developing new assays. The qualified individual we are seeking will join an ongoing research effort in cellular and clinical pharmacology that encompasses both preclinical evaluation of investigational anticancer agents as well as clinical research. The position will provide an outstanding clinical scientist with an opportunity to establish himself or herself as an independent investigator. The individual will conduct clinical trials that incorporate clinical pharmacology and intracellular pharmacodynamic endpoints. Additional clinical responsibilities will include serving as attending physician in the outpatient Oncology Clinic, inpatient ward, and consult service.
